#### What are the target groups for the examination?

Students in the following grades: first primary, fourth primary, first intermediate, and first secondary



#### Where is the examination performed?

Inside schools, and in primary health care centers





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#### What examinations the program detects?

- Investigating medical history, particularly chronic
- diseases and disabilities
- Investigating completion of basic vaccinations Early detection of:
- Obesity, overweight and thinness (body mass)
- Tooth decay
- Visual acuity
- Hearing impairment
- Depression
- Attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD)
- Smoking
- Scoliosis
- Temporary guidance per case
- Referral by case

#### What next, when a health problem is detected?

The student will be referred to the healthcare center to monitor his health condition



### Who conducts the medical examination of the student in the school?

A team comprising: a doctor, dentist and nurse



### How often the examination is conducted for the student during his educational journey?

The exploratory examination is conducted four times at different school stages
