Subject:Weather ChangesAddressed to:Hospitals Directors, Maintenance Managers,<br/>Maintenance Engineers, Safety OfficersThe Problem:In this time of every year, Saudi Arabia encounters<br/>unstable weather with sever sand storms and sudden<br/>rain showers. Therefore, you have to implement few<br/>precautions to ensure patients and employees safety.

## **Recommendations**:

- 1. Ensure ground rainwater channels are cleaned and free from obstacles.
- 2. Check the lightning prevention system.
- 3. Clean the rainwater and drain manholes.
- 4. Properly secure external signs, poles, boards, and fixtures.
- 5. Maintain roof drains and remove any dirt.
- 6. Cap all external electrical panels and junction boxes.
- 7. Make sure the roof floors and yards floor slopes are not altered.
- 8. Ensure the integrity of the roof waterproofing membrane.
- 9. Check the medical air dryers are properly working.
- 10. Test the rainwater and sewage pumps.
- 11. Stock extra quantity of AHU air filters.
- 12. Close any "unintended" openings in the walls, doors, and windows to prevent seeping dust.
