

Hepatitis C

Liver is the organ that filters out toxins from the blood and fights inflammation. When exposed to infection or damage, its vital functions are affected, while the use of alcohol, toxins or some medications in specific medical conditions, could lead to hepatitis. However, Hepatitis is mainly caused by the introduction of viruses (A-B-C-D-E).

Yellowing of the skin and eyes (jaundice), dark urine, nausea and vomiting are the most common symptoms of all types of liver infections. In some cases, the patient heals without complications or medical intervention, while in some other cases it may develop into a chronic disease such as Cirrhosis or Liver Cancer.
